# GROUNDS

March is a month that gives a hint of hope for those of us still in the grip of winter - a brief glimpse of what is to come in spring with some sunny days and warming temperatures. Sometimes it seems to whisper- *all is okay, just be a little patient as good things are around the corner!* Here is some activity from the grounds crew.

**Short Game Area** - I recently read an article in Golf Digest about the best way amateurs can break 100, 90 or 80 is to practice their short game. As mentioned in previous Smoke Signals, we have developed plans for a short game practice area near the 18th green. The area has been staked out already and is visible from the clubhouse.

In order to make this happen, we are asking for donations from our Members. When we asked for the assessment last year, we did not include funds for this project. The cost is estimated at \$68,000. Our March Madness fund raiser should raise approximately \$9,000 for this project. Several anonymous donors have pledged \$25,000 of matching funds if the project starts this summer. Therefore, we need an additional \$34,000 to make this happen this summer. We have received pledges for some of the \$34,000 but we are still short of our goal. We ask that you consider donating funds for this project. Please contact Laurie Rhed (219-872-8624, ext 102) if you are interested in donating.

One final note on the short game area. If we do not raise the additional \$34,000 by April 15th, we will lose the matching funds and will not start this project this summer. The project will be reconsidered as part of our fall planning process. Pledged money will be billed to accounts on May 1, 2023, only if the goal of \$34,000 is reached. If the goal is not reached, all pledges made will be canceled. Funds obtained from the March Madness pool will be set aside to fund the project in the future.

**Course Conditions** - I recently had the pleasure of walking the course on a beautiful day to see the extensive clearing that was done by the grounds crew, especially the assistant groundskeeper Nate Johnson. Nate took full advantage of the warmer than normal weather in February and efficiently removed multiple dead and/or overgrown trees and shrubs using a specialty excavator machine. The many removals seemed to open the imaginary curtain, further exposing the beauty of our surroundings. Trail Creek is an amazingly attractive and scenic Godgiven amenity given to The Club that has inadvertently been kept hidden. As the days warm up and the spring growth begins, I encourage you all to walk the course and take in its beauty. Please feel free to share our secret with your friends and family. I think they too will marvel at its beauty.

Our new bridges and beautifully groomed vistas throughout the entire course, thanks to our diligent and dedicated grounds crew, is intensifying the natural beauty of Pottawattomie! We are making serious progress on the new concrete cart path that goes from the 11th green to the bottom of the hill on the 12th hole. This portion of the path will most likely be completed by mid Spring thanks to a generous donation from one of our Members.

Being Members of Pottawattomie Country Club, we are fortunate to be a part of this beautiful and long-lasting treasure that dates back over 114 years. It is our collective plan to consistently maintain and improve upon our golf architect and designer Tom Bendelow's vision and plan. I think he would be proud of what we have further achieved with his plans. With that thought in mind, the Pottawattomie Board is preparing a survey to get your ideas and feedback on what you, as a Pottawattomie Member, want to see happen to our golf course as part of our long-range planning.

Hard to believe it's the beginning of March already! Spring is right around the corner and most of the winter and cold weather is hopefully behind us. There are a lot of exciting things going on at Pottawattomie involving the golf program and The Golf Shop.

First and foremost, our new Director of Golf, Justin Stevens, is settling in nicely. He recently returned from the winter PGA convention in Orlando and brought back many new ideas and a refreshed enthusiasm for his passion as a certified PGA Teaching Pro. He and Mike Nygren are diligently working at managing the much-used golf simulator, giving lessons on same and getting The Golf Shop stocked and ready for the 2023 season.

The Golf Simulator has been up and running since early January and its use has been steadily increasing. You can practice your game, play on a number of renowned courses or take a lesson from one of our PGA pros (call The Golf Shop to make arrangements, 219-872-0624). Use of the simulator is included in all Golf Memberships for primary Members and their partners at no charge. A fee of \$10/reservation is charged for Social Members and guests (billed to your Pottawattomie account). You can reserve the simulator for a two-hour block of time on the "Team Reach" app (group name Pottsim) or by calling The Club or The Golf Shop. Bar/beverage service is typically available during hours of operation. Now that Gus is back from his winter break, there will be limited weekend offerings from the kitchen as well.

The Golf and Grounds Committees have been busy over the winter completing plans for a sixth set of tees on our course, designated the "Green Tees". This setup will play significantly shorter than the current Red Tees at approximately 4700 yards. Green Tees will be rated and sloped by the CDGA, hopefully in time for the official start of the season. We feel the shorter course set up will be especially enjoyed by our more novice golfers and junior golfers. We encourage you to try the new Green Tees once they become available.

Plans for development of a short game practice area, as detailed by Bob Mathes in the last issue of Smoke Signals, have been finalized. Once operational, hopefully by the fall of this year, the chipping and sand practice facility will help all of us improve our short games. VERY EXCITING!!



The Men's 2023 Golf Schedule has been finalized. In an effort to enhance access to the course on weekends, we have done our best to limit golf events and/or tournaments. Last year's participation in our Club's golfing events was near record setting. Event format information is available in The Golf Shop. 
#### **Guidelines for Posting Out of Season Scores**

The USGA Rules of Handicapping states: A score is acceptable for handicap purposes if the round has been played on a golf course during its active season. The active season for the Chicago District is April 1-October 31. However, many parts of our country have a year round active golf season.

- The last day of the CDGA and CWDGA official season is the last day that scores for rounds played at golf clubs in the Chicago District can be posted for handicap purposes.
- Rounds played after that date (no matter how good the weather might be) within our District or in any section of the country that is "off-season" are not acceptable for posting.
- If you play golf during the winter months in a section of the country that is "in-season" (e.g., Florida, Arizona, Southern California, etc.), those scores are to be posted for handicap purposes.
- You can post scores from the "Sun Belt" through My CDGA Caddie (website) or My CDGA (app).

If you have a membership number through another association it is important to link that number with your CDGA number for the purposes of the World Handicap System. Contact **Lynn Boyd**, CDGA senior director of handicapping, at (630) 685-2304 with the information that you are a member of another club in another part of the country and provide your additional association number. Once linked, you will see that all of your scores will be combined as part of the World Handicap System.





Happy March! The simulator has been very well received as it has been very active with regular play. If you're interested in signing up to get a few swings in before the course opens, go to the App Store, find and download TeamReach, enter code Pottsim. This will allow you to see what times are available and book your own time or group.

#### **GOLF SIMULATOR GUIDELINES**

- Hours of Operation: Wednesday thru Saturday 12-8pm, Sunday 11am-4pm.
- Reservations must be made by calling Pottawattomie (219-872-8624) or on the teamreach app (username is pottsim).
- Use of the simulator is limited to four people per hour. This same group of four may not reserve more than two consecutive one-hour intervals, with the second hour being reserved by a name different from the name used in the first hour.
- Individual reservations are limited to one one-hour time slot.
- Golf Members, as well as their significant partner, are able to use the simulator on a complimentary basis.
- Social Members are able to use the simulator at \$10/hour.
- Golf and/or Social Members are allowed to bring guests to use the simulator at \$10/person/hour. All guests must be accompanied by at least one Golf and/or Social Member.
- Private lessons can be arranged with Pottawattomie's Director of Golf Operations Justin Stevens.
